### Dear North Dakota Hereford Breeders:

What a year for extremes, early drought in the south and parts of the central plains to extreme late moisture for the fall harvest; it has been a year of challenges. However, whatever Mother Nature throws at us, the Hereford Breed perseveres.

For the first time since 2004, the American Hereford Association reached 81,174 registrations. Certified Hereford Beef had a record year as well with 58.8 million pounds of product sold.

I want to visit with you all about the Whole Cow Herd DNA Project, offering through December 31, 2018. As you know the intent of this program is to obtain valuable genomic information on females in production to accompany the 18 years of TPR data that the AHA's diligent breeders have collected. Adding the genomic components to key female traits backed by strong records can do nothing but strengthen the genetic prediction of future generations of seed-stock.

For only \$20 per cow on inventory you will get a genetic profile and parentage test, the three abnormality results and a customized Tissue Sample Unit (TSU). Other wise this test would cost \$38 for a savings of \$18 per cow.

**2017 NSC Donation Heifer** was donated by Carl Olson Hereford Ranch, Argusville, ND. Gary Freidt from Freidt Herefords, Mott, ND won the raffle drawing, and graciously donated the heifer back to the NDHA to be auctioned off. Friesz Livestock, New Salem, ND purchased the heifer. Thank you Carl and family for your support of the Assn. Proceeds from the sale of the donation heifer are used for NDHA Hereford promotion.

**Junior Heifer Grant Applications** are due to Joana Friesz by November 28, 2017 – application is enclosed and also can be found on the NDHA website. Past juniors receiving a heifer grant are eligible to apply again. Junior must be present during the sale – 3 – \$250 grants will be given by the NDHA and the Klein Family Memorial grant of \$500 by Bruce and Cody Klein and Pat Weber, and \$500 by Tinjum family, Andrew Dosch Memorial.

**North Star Classic Results**, December 2, 2017: 12 head of heifer calves averaged \$2270.83. High selling heifer was Lot 6 consigned by Friesz Livestock selling to Lacey Wolfekuhle, Wolverton, MN. 2 head of steers averaged \$1425 – Emily Huber Family took Friedt Herefords' Lot 24 for \$1600. 3 bred heifers averaged \$2833. Friesz Livestock sold Lot 20 to Aaseth Family of Velva, ND for \$3300 and Lot 19 to Seefeld Polled Herefords of Harvey, ND for \$2700. Donation heifer sponsored by Olson Hereford Ranch was won by Gary Friedt, Mott, ND, and donated back to NDHA to resell, and was then bought by Friesz Livestock of New Salem, ND.

**2017 NDHA Hereford Breeder of the Year** is the Bruce Klein and Pat Weber family. The Klein family raises Hereford cattle near Scranton, North Dakota. This family has sponsored a \$500 memorial grant for any junior who wishes to purchase a Hereford heifer at the North Star Hereford Sale. This grant has been offered for eight consecutive years. Ashley Geidd was the first junior to receive the Klein Family Memorial Heifer Grant. This year' NDHA's recipient is Kaleb Neshem from Berthold, North Dakota. # 2017 NDHA ANNUAL MEETING MINUTES

Friday, December 1, 2017 • Valley City, ND

November 2018

Carl Olson called the meeting to order. The Secretary's report from the 2016 Annual Meeting was in the newsletter. Zac Tessier made a motion to dispense the reading of the minutes and 2nd by Duane Keller. Joana Friesz handed out the Treasurer's report and reviewed with the members. Motion to accept by Steve Wolff and 2nd by Gary Friedt.

Old Business: The 2017 NSC heifer is provided by Carl Olson Family, Argusville, ND. Thank you to Olson's for their generous donation. We will be looking for a heifer for the 2018 sale.

Discussion was held regarding the 2 page ad in the annual Hereford issue of the ND Stockmen's Magazine – one page with Hereford artwork and opposite page with membership listing done in black and white. Everyone was in agreement to keep going ahead with that type of ad.

Shane Giedd gave the Junior Association annual report. He also was representing the NDSU Saddle and Sirloin Club. They were looking for a donated Hereford heifer to be raffled with the proceeds going towards the livestock judging team travel expenses. Shane asked if anyone would be interested in donating a heifer to contact him. Pete Atkins, AHA director from Tea, SD was in attendance to our meeting and mentioned that the annual judging team reunion will be held at SDSU.

Friesz reported that she had received 5 heifer grant applications back from juniors. The Klein family memorial of \$500 was in its 8th year of their 10 year commitment in generously offering the grant. Friesz mentioned that Larry Tinjum of Powers Lake had contacted her that he and Larry Tinjum would offer a \$500 grant in memory of the late Andrew Dosch of Powers Lake, ND. Friesz had received \$25 from an anonymous donor to be used as the Association sees fit. Gary Friedt made a motion to add to the \$500 Dosch grant from Tinjum and was 2nd by Steve Wolff.

Zac Tessier reported on the Hereford Influenced Sale that was held in Bowman, ND in October. There was about 750 head that sold and the market was a bit weak that week and some of the buyers didn't make it to the sale due to illness. Discussion was held regarding different dates and locations. Zac would explore some other options and anyone else that wants to help him out.

Friesz reported that the banquet will be held at the AmericInn this year – the Bridger Bar and Grill indicated that they could cater the meal. Social at 6:30 pm followed by meal at 7 pm Saturday evening.

New Business: Friesz reported that the semen auction is to be held during the banquet – she has 7 breeders donating semen. Behm's, Stroh's, Tessier's, Stuber's, Friesz's, Pelton's, and Topp's. Thank you donors!

Pete Atkins and Levi Landers reported that there is new staff at CHB and that they are working with National Beef to get more CHB retailers.

There was discussion regarding radio advertising during bull sale season. Motion made by Gary Friedt and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Steve Wolff to look into cost and coverage and keep the budget in the \$1000-\$1500 range. Gary Friedt and Carl Olson will look into some options with different stations and get it set up. Coverage to start by mid-January through mid-April to cover the breeders having bull sales both live auction and private treaty – ad will cover the advantages of using a Hereford bull – not breeder specific.

The proposed budget was reviewed and a motion to accept made by Steve Wolff and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Zac Tessier.

Bruce Klein suggested that there should be some recognition for the commercial Hereford breeder within the Assn. The board will look into that.

Discussion was held regarding the future of the NSC. Each year there seems to be uncertainty based on the current manager whether there will be another NSC. We should have some possible options to relocate if the NSC would no longer exist. Duane Keller reported that he talked to the Bowman Chamber of Commerce and Lynn James from Bowman expressed an interest that they would be interested in hosting the event and pay 90% of the expenses. After more discussion, Keller would need to get a written bid as to what could be for NDHA and what facilities they have for washing livestock and housing in the winter.

Steve Wolff casted a unanimous ballot to re-elect Todd Kuelbs and Craig Pelton for director terms (2<sup>nd</sup> for both) and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Duane Keller. Steve Wolff nominated Mark Giedd to replace Rollie Baumgarten's term that was up for central director. Gary Friedt 2<sup>nd</sup>.

Duane Keller made a motion to adjourn meeting and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Leon Seefeld.

President Andy Mrnak called the meeting to order.

Andy asked to resign from President due to his job commitments and asked to be a director for the SW. Motion made by Todd Kuelbs and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Zac Tessier.

Motion made by Carl Olson to elect Zac Tessier for Vice President, 2<sup>nd</sup> by Todd Kuelbs.

Motion made by Andy Mrnak to re-elect Joana Friesz for Sec/Treas. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Zac Tessier.

All motions carried.

Carl Olson made a motion to adjourn and 2<sup>nd</sup> by Leon Seefeld.

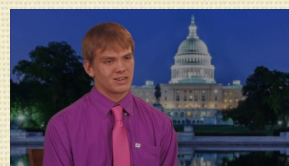
