November 2019

Carl Olson called the meeting to order. The secretary's report from the 2017 annual meeting was in the newsletter. Chris Rockeman made motion to approve the minutes and 2nd by Jimmy Carter. Joana handed out the treasurer's report and reviewed with the members. Motion to accept by Zac Tessier and 2nd by Steve Wolff.

**Old Business:** The 2018 NSC heifer is donated by Larry and Logan Behm of Behm Polled Herefords, Beulah, ND. Thank you to the Behm's for their generosity. Andy Mrnak of Mrnak Hereford Ranch, Bowman, ND indicated that they would donate the 2019 NSC heifer.

Discussion was held regarding the 2 page ad the NDHA has in the March issue of the ND Stockmen's magazine – one page with membership listing and opposite page (black and white) with AHA ad slick and officers and directors. Everyone thought it was good to continue with this 2 page ad.

Levi mentioned that the deadline for the Whole Cow Herd DNA Genomic program is December 31st. Must request to participate by December 31st and work with AHA on submitting the samples.

Radio advertising was discussed – everyone thought the ad info and price of advertising (\$1000-\$1500 budget) on KFYR was a good investment during bull sale season (ad to cover the benefits of using a Hereford bull– no breeder specific) starting late January into mid April. Shane Giedd mentioned that the NDSU judging club was looking for a Hereford heifer for their 2019 fund raising raffle. If anyone is interested to contact Shane for more information.

**Director Elections:** Zac Tessier nominated Matt Stroh for the NW region – Steve Wolff made motion to close nominations. LaMae Turk 2nd. Shane Giedd cast unanimous ballot to elect Matt Stroh and 2nd by LaMae. Motion carried.

Steve Wolff made motion to re-elect Zac Tessier for SW region and 2nd by Shane Giedd. Chris Rockeman made motion to cast unanimous ballot and 2nd by Shane to elect Zac. Motion carried.

#### ND Hereford Steer Shows:

The NDHA sponsors Hereford steer premiums each year at the ND Junior Hereford field day held during the ND State Fair in Minot, ND and at the Great Plains Regional Junior Hereford Show held in July during the Red River Valley Fair, West Fargo, ND.

The NDHA will pay \$200 for champion and \$100 for reserve champion steers for the NDJHA filed day event. They must be from a registered sire and dam with the AHA.

The Great Plains Junior Hereford Show pays as follows: Grand Champion Market Steer Award & \$157.50 Reserve Grand Champion Market Steer Award & \$78.75 Breeder of Champion Steer Award & \$78.75 Breeder of Reserve Champion Steer Award & \$15.75.

There is also a junior show featuring a Hereford steer show during the Midwest Classic Jr. Hereford Show in Pipestone, MN in June.

2018 NDHA Commercial Breeder of the Year

Larry and his wife Jill and son Richard (pictured). Larry and his family has been a generous junior heifer grant donor in memory of the late Andrew Dosch for the past few years. He donates \$500 for the awarded NDJHA member to be used to purchase a heifer out of the Hereford Sale at the North Star Classic In Valley City in the first Saturday in December.

Tinjum Herefords is a commercial cow-calf operation located east of Powers Lake, ND. Richard Tinjum came from Minnesota in 1911 to homestead here. n 1948 his son Clarence bought the first Hereford cows. In 1950 he sold his brother Ervin five heifers with which he started his own herd. Clarence wintered and calved the cows, while Ervin fed and finished the calves until they were ready to be shipped by rail to St. Paul. Beginning in the early 1960s they operated separately selling the calves at weaning in October except for replacement heifers. Over the years they bought bulls from many ND breeders including J.B. Schou, George O'Malley, Roen Bros., Diamond J,Herman Widicker, Dennis Lindberg and Edson Lund. For over 30 years they bought most of their herd sires from Lodoen Herefords at Westhope.

In 1971 Ervin's son Larry returned home full time and purchased his uncle Clarence's herd and together they ran 150 cows. In 2009 Andrew Dosch purchased heifers from Tinjums and became a partner with Larry and his son Richard. In 2012 Andrew moved to the original Tinjum homestead and established Dosch Hereford Ranch working with the Tinjums until his death in 2017. The last ten years most bulls have been purchased from Mrnak Herefords at Bowman. Bulls and heifers were also purchased from Helbing Herefords at Mandan and heifers from Behm Herefords at Des Lacs.
